1. Assignments

Assignment 1

In your country map key UHC and SRHR actors including:

- Government agencies and ministries
- Civil society organizations
- Private sector
- Development partners/UN organizations

Your list does not have to be exhaustive, instead try to identify the most important actors for each group and provide a short comment to why they are important.



2. Activities

Activity 1 (90 minutes)

Break the participants up into small groups and ask them to discuss the following questions for 45 minutes:

- Is UHC a priority in your country?
- If so, What shows the level of prioritization of UHC?
- What challenges hinder progress to UHC in your country?
- How can CSOs engage to support the UHC progress in your country?

Ask one participant from each group to report back to the larger group. Facilitate a discussion to develop group consensus on how CSOs can best engage to support the UHC progress in their countries.

Activity 2 (90 minutes)

Break the participants up into small groups and ask them to discuss the following questions for 45 minutes:

- Is SRHR a priority in your country?
- How is SRHR linked to UHC in your country context?
- What challenges hinder effective linkage of SRHR to UHC in your country?
- How can CSOs engage to support the linkage of SRHR to UHC in your country?

Ask one participant from each group to report back to the larger group. Facilitate a discussion to develop group consensus on how CSOs can best engage to support the support the linkage of SRHR to UHC in their countries.

Activity 3: (90 minutes)

Break the participants into small groups and ask them to discuss the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on the financing of health, including Sexual and Reproductive Health, in Low- and Middle-Income Countries. Each group and to prepare a brief presentation (Maximum 10 slides on Power Point & Maximum 7.5 Minutes long) and present to the rest of the participants during the feedback session.
